### ***Mac OS X Driver v. 5.2.0-6 Posted***

Today Wacom Technology Corp. (WTC) posted a new driver for consumer pen tablets on Macs running **Mac OS X v. 10.4, 10.5 & 10.6**. It works in both the native and classic environment of OS X.

This driver supports **all Bamboo tablets, the Graphire4, Graphire Bluetooth & Graphire3 pen tablets, and the Cintiq 17SX, DTF-720, DTU-710, DTF-521 & DTF-510 pen displays.**

The driver can be downloaded from WTC's website at [www.wacom.com/productsupport/select.cfm](http://www.wacom.com/productsupport/select.cfm). Save the file to your computer and then double-click on "Install Pen Tablet" to launch the installer.

#### Wacom implemented the following changes and improvements:

- This driver fully supports Mac OS X v.10.6 (Snow Leopard).
- This driver includes support for the new Bamboo pen and touch tablets. The size of the download is larger than previous drivers due to the additional touch driver functionality.
- The "Remove Tablet" utility now contains an option to back up your preferences and to restore the backed up preferences at a later time.
  - To back up your preferences, select Go – Applications – Pen Tablet (or Bamboo) – Remove Pen Tablet (or Remove Bamboo). After the utility launched, select "Back-up ...", choose the name and location of the backup file, and click OK.
  - To restore your previously saved preferences, select Go – Applications – Pen Tablet (or Bamboo) – Remove Pen Tablet (or Remove Bamboo). After the utility launched, select "Restore ...", browse to the location of your backup file and select it, and click on OK.

Note: the name of this utility will be updated in an upcoming driver release.

- Some issues with handling keystroke commands were resolved.
- A number of smaller bug fixes and improvements were implemented.

This driver is a slightly updated version of the shipping driver for Bamboo 2<sup>nd</sup> Generation. All users are encouraged to report issues or bugs in this driver to Wacom, for consideration in a future release of this driver.
